- It's 1815 eruption was the largest volcanic eruption in recorded history
- Has three volcanic cones and is the highest free-standing mountain in the world.
 - An active stratovolcano in Japan
- A snow-capped dormant volcano said to be the resting spot of Noah's arc
- Is considered one of the most dangerous volcanoes in the world and contains glacier ice
